

Quilts in My Garden

Information Sheet

Date: July 19, 2008, 10:00 – 4:00

Admission: \$20 includes lunch at Meaford Hall's Terrace room. Tickets will be sold by lunch times in 45 minute segments. Tickets to the tour of quilts sold only on the day will be \$14 and will not include lunch.

Raffle: A raffle of a handmade quilt called "*Café & Teal*" sewn and hand quilted by the Friendship Circle Quilters are \$2 each or 3/\$5. They will be placed with posters detailing the tour event in quilt shops and interested outlets throughout our region as well as Bruce Peninsula through to Kitchener/Waterloo regions. **Draw to take place at the event (probably the last lunch time).**

The event: Quilts in My Garden is presented by the Meaford Hall & Culture Foundation, as part of our summer-long celebration of the 100th anniversary of Meaford Hall. Some details of the event are:

- Raffle tickets will be printed with information about the quilt/garden tour on the back.
- 1000 tour tickets will be printed and sold by committee members, at the Foundation office
- Lunch times will be at 1) 11:00 – 11:45; 2) 11:45 – 12:30; 3) 12:30 – 1:15; 4) 1:15 – 2:00; and 5) 2:00 – 2:45 p.m. in the Terrace room and on the terrace of Meaford Hall.
- An antique quilt display sponsored by the museum in the art gallery.
- A mini trade show is planned with 4 area quilt shops participating.
- Advertising is being sent to relevant periodicals: Canadian Living/Gardening; Harrowsmith; quilting magazines as well as to local publications.
- Quilts will be provided by local artisans and displayed in 7 gardens.
- Suggested that quilts will be hung in every available place for the day.
- The Friendship Circle quilters will make aprons for garden attendants, and table top coverings for the lunch room
- Lunch will be a salad with chicken breast slices, rolls, dessert, tea & coffee.

Surroundings: Meaford Hall is located only steps away from the beautiful Meaford Harbour and Marina located on Georgian Bay. It is also in the heart of the downtown area where there are many interesting shopping opportunities including the Museum and Candle Factory.
